Christ, the Light of the World, Calls Us to Proclaim His Gospel of Life

Today, Sunday, January 22, 2017, marks the 44th anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*, a decision by the United States Supreme Court, which decriminalized the grave sin of abortion during all nine months of a woman's pregnancy. As a result of this unconstitutional act of judicial overreach and incompetency, *over 50 million* of our totally innocent brothers and sisters have died.
