I. Baker City Council 849 Scholarship:

The annual Baker City Council 849 Scholarship was established to assist Roman Catholic students in furthering their education

II. Eligibility:

Scholarship(s) will be awarded to a high school senior(s) chosen according to the following provisions:

- A. Application for the scholarship must be written or typed on the form approved by the council. Applications are to be turned into St. Francis deSales Parish Office no later than **Tuesday May 1st, 2018.**
- B. Applicants must be a member of St. Francis deSales Cathedral Parish, Baker City, OR, or a member of the Mission Parish in Halfway or North Powder.
- C. The scholarship will be paid to the college, university or technical school of the student's selection, for payment of tuition, books or room and board.

III. Selection:

Through comprehensive evaluation of the application and letter of recommendation submitted, and discussion among committee members, the scholarship committee will evaluate each applicant according to the following criteria:

- A. Christian Involvement: This will be based on the individual's active participation in Church youth programs and activities, his/her self-involvement with helping or caring for other individuals and written support from a parish member.

If, after evaluation of these criteria, there is a "tie" among applicants, the selection committee would then consider the following judgmental criteria:

- B. Personal Attitude
- C. Moral Character
- D. Motivation

After reviewing and evaluating each application submitted the committee will select scholarship recipients.
