This Blessing is a centuries old tradition that you as a family can do on the feast of the Epiphany. The blessing has biblical roots tied to the Passover in the book of Exodus 12:1-13. It takes place on the Epiphany marking the visitation of the Magi to

the Christ Child and the revelation that Jesus is the son of God. This traditional home blessing will serve as a symbol of hope and a visible reminder of faith and will be a strong reminder of how important God is to us and what an important factor Jesus is in our daily lives. Traditionally the priest blesses chalk on the Feast of the Epiphany by saying the following prayer:

Bless, + O lord God, this creature, chalk, and let it be a help to mankind. Grant that those who will use it with faith in your most holy name, and with it inscribe on the doors of their homes the names of your saints, Casper, Melchior, and Baltassar, may through their merits and intercession enjoy health in body and protection of soul; through Christ our Lord.

Instructions and chalk will be available at the office and after Mass on the 31st and 1st.

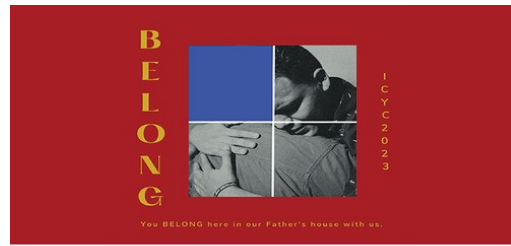
