### St. Francis de Sales Cathedral Windows—Part 2

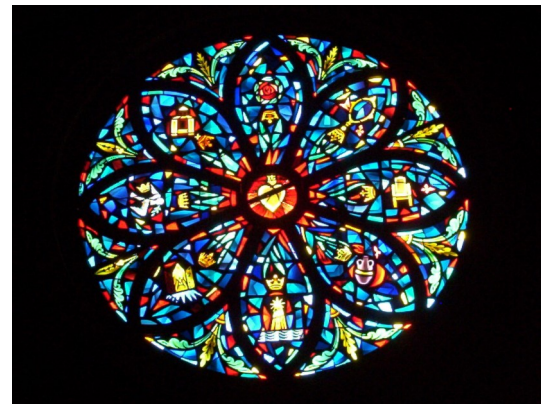
Located on the east side over the window depicting Pentecost is the rose window with 8 symbols that identify the Litany of the Sacred Heart. Each quote begins with Heart of Jesus. Reading from the top clockwise:

- ◆ House "house of God and gate of heaven"
- ◆ Crown "King and center of all hearts"
- ◆ Yoke "loaded down with harsh criticism or censure. "bruised for our offences." "obedient unto death."
- ◆ Burner "burning furnace of charity".
- ◆ Bible "in whom are all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge."
- ◆ Scale "abode of justice and love."
- ◆ Font "fountain of life and holiness."
- ◆ Lance "pierced with a lance".

The Rose window on the west side includes symbols of the Blessed Virgin Mary as contained in the Litany of Loreto. Reading from the top clockwise.

Mystical Rose – Mirror of Justice – Seat of Wisdom – Vessel of Honor—Morning Star – Gate of Heaven – Queen of Peace – House of Gold

The center of the Rose window for the Blessed Virgin Mary contains the Sacred Heart and the center of the Rose window for the Sacred Heart contains the Ark of the Covenant which has symbolically referred to the Blessed Virgin. This appears to be an error, since the designer's correspondence on the windows indicates that it should be reversed.
