The Seven Sorrows (Dolors) of the Blessed Virgin

September is the month of the Seven Sorrows of the Blessed Virgin and on the 15th we celebrate the Seven Sorrows of the Blessed Virgin.

1. The Prophecy of Simon: Luke 2:34-35

-"Behold this child if appointed for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign that is opposed (and a sword will pierce

through your own soul also), so that thoughts from many hearts will be revealed."

- 2. The Flight into Egypt: Matthew 2:13-21 Tells of an angel appearing to Joseph telling him to flee into Egypt as Herod is searching for the child (Christ) to destroy him.
- 3. Loss of Jesus for 3 days: Luke 2:41-50 Tells of when Mary and Joseph were leaving Jerusalem after the Feast of the Passover and discovered Jesus was not with them and later found him in the temple among the teachers.
- 4. The Carrying of the cross: John 19:17 So they took Jesus and he went out bearing his own cross, to the place called the Place of the Skull, which in Aramaic is call Golgatha.
- 5. The Crucifixion: John 19:18-30 Tells of Christ being crucified, Pilate placing a sign on the cross "The King of the Jews", the dividing of his garment, and his death.
- 6. Jesus taken down from the cross: John 19:38-40 Tells of Joseph of Arimathea asking Pilate for permission to take away the body of Jesus.
- 7. Jesus Laid in the tomb: John 19:39-42 Tells of Nicodemus bringing a mixture of myrrh and aloes and binding Jesus' body in linen cloths and being laid in a tomb.
