Planned Parenthood has opened an abortion clinic in Ontario and is assisting women from Idaho to come to Ontario for an abortion. In light of this Bishop Cary has asked all parishes in the Diocese to make a pilgrimage to Ontario to pray

for the end to abortion and the closing of the clinic.

Friday September 29th was our day to make the pilgrimage to Ontario. We left Baker at 8:30am and arrived in Ontario at 11:00am (time difference) to celebrate Mass with Father Suresh. Father Joseph passed out signs and gave us the run down on dos and don'ts. Such as do not step on the Clinic's property. (The police were called on an earlier group because someone sat on a low wall that surrounds the property. Nothing happened and they got a thumbs up from the office that answered the call.) Following the mass, we walked to the Planned Parenthood Clinic. There were 29 parishioners including four from St. Therese's in Halfway and two men who asked to join us. This was not a demonstration or protest, simply a time to pray. We stood

on the sidewalk and were lead in the rosary by John Fuzi and Luke Gilmer and in prayers by Sean Fuzi. We held signs that showed why we were there, one in particular caught my attention "STOP ABORTION TOURISM." The reaction from the traffic passing by was interesting, we had lots of thumbs up and some thumbs down, two cars cursed at us. It was interesting to note that a lot of the thumbs up were from vehicles with Idaho plates! We spent approximately two hours in prayer and then quietly headed home. Please continue to pray for an end to abortion.
