What is the Chrism Mass?

The Chrism Mass is the time the bishop blesses the Holy Oils that are used throughout the year. The Mass is usually held on Holy Thursday, however because of the large area our diocese covers it is held the week prior due to the distance the priests must travel. During this mass the priests, deacons and representatives of the entire diocesan community gather around the Bishop and during the liturgy, the entire assembly is called to renew its baptismal promises; deacons and priests also renew their vow of obedience to the local bishop and their commitment to serve God's people. It is during this Mass the bishop bless the Holy Oils for the coming year. Whenever the Holy Oils are used in a diocese, the ministry of the bishop who consecrated them is symbolically present.
