On Monday, May 19, 2025 a relic of Blessed Michael McGivney, will be here in the Cathedral with Mass at 9:00am. Blessed Michael McGivney was born of Irish Immigrant parents in 1852 in Waterbury, Conn, and began his priestly ministry in 1877. This was a time when many Catholic immigrants were struggling to adapt to a new way of life. On March 29, 1882 he founded the Knights of Columbus as a mutual aid society to provide financial assistance to widows and orphans. He died from pneumonia in 1884 at the age of 34. On October 31, 2020 the beatification Mass of Michael McGivney was celebrated at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford, Connecticut with Cardinal Joseph W. Tobin presiding on the Pope's behalf.
