2<sup>nd</sup> grade (1<sup>st</sup> Communion)

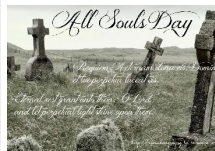
3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> grade
