Ash Wednesday (March 5th) is the beginning of the Season of Lent. This is a time of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter.

You will notice that Father wears purple vestments during lent and that is to remind us that Jesus was dressed in purple as they mocked him as "King of the Jews". The Church has certain rules we follow during Lent: **Those 14 and up are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. – Those 18-59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. You can eat one full meal with additional meals not to exceed the one full meal. Historically we offer something up for Lent, lets think about that, what can I do that will help make me a better person and prepare me for the Resurrection?**
