Religious Education



Time for wearing of the green to honor St. Patrick and the Emerald Isle and keep those mischievous leprechauns at bay. Just who is this Saint that inspires us to be Irish one day of the year.

St. Patrick is believed to have been born in the early 5th century in Britain. As a teenager he was captured by a group of Irish pirates and taken to Ireland where he was held captive for six years. After six years of captivity, he escaped and returned home where he studied Christianity.

A few years after returning home he had a vision of a man coming from Ireland and urging him to return there as a Christian Missionary. It is believed he travelled around Ireland and he claimed of the Irish: "Never before did they know of God except to serve idols and unclean things. But now they have become the people of the Lord, and are called children of God. The sons and daughters of the leaders of the Irish are seen to be monks and virgins of Christ!"

Patrick has never been formally canonized by a pope which was common before the great schism of 1054. He is the patron saint of Ireland and March 17th (the date of his death) is a holy day of obligation in Ireland.
