Rite of Election — A Step Closer to Easter

On Saturday, February 21st at 2:00 p.m., our catechumens will participate in the Rite of Election with **Bishop Thomas Hennen**, along with other catechumens from around the Diocese of Baker. This special liturgy marks a key step in their journey toward receiving the Sacraments of Initiation — Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist — at the Easter Vigil.

The Rite of Election formally recognizes those who have responded to God's call and completed a period of preparation through prayer, study, and reflection. During the celebration, their names are entered into the Church's **Book of the Elect**, a sign of both their commitment and the Church's welcome.

This rite also begins the season of **Purification and Enlightenment**, a time for deeper prayer, reflection, and conversion leading up to Easter.

While this is a pivotal moment for the elect, it is also a beautiful opportunity for the entire parish to unite in prayer and support for our brothers and sisters. Let us pray that they continue to grow in faith as they approach the celebration of Easter.
