Second Sunday of Lent – Listening to the Beloved Son

On the Second Sunday of Lent, the Church leads us up a high mountain with Peter, James, and John to witness the Transfiguration of the Lord. After the trials and temptations of the desert in the first week of Lent, this moment of glory is given to strengthen the disciples — and us — for the journey toward the Cross.

In the Gospel, Jesus is revealed in radiant light, and the voice of the Father declares, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him." These words are at the heart of our Lenten call. Lent is not only about sacrifice; it is about deeper listening — setting aside the noise of our busy lives so that we can hear the voice of Christ more clearly in Scripture, in prayer, and in the quiet of our hearts.

The disciples wanted to remain on the mountain, in the beauty of that holy moment. But Jesus leads them back down, because the Christian life is not lived apart from the world but within it — carrying the light of Christ into our daily lives, our families, our workplaces, and our parish community.

This Sunday reminds us that penance and sacrifice are not ends in themselves. They are meant to transform us, to open our eyes to who Jesus truly is, and to prepare us for the glory of Easter. The glimpse of divine light given at the Transfiguration assures us that the Cross is not the end of the story.

As we continue our Lenten journey, we are invited to ask ourselves:
Are we making time to truly listen to Him?
Are we allowing His light to change us?

May this holy season draw us up the mountain in prayer, so that, renewed and strengthened, we may walk more faithfully in the way of Christ
