The Most Holy Trinity

This Sunday, May 31st, 2026, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity — the mystery of one God in three Divine Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. While the Trinity is a mystery beyond our full understanding, it is at the very heart of our Catholic faith.

From the beginning of our lives as Christians, we are marked by the Trinity. We are baptized "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit," and every prayer, Mass, and sacrament draws us deeper into the life of the Triune God.

The Holy Trinity is not simply a theological concept, but a relationship of perfect love. The Father eternally loves the Son, the Son loves the Father, and the Holy Spirit is the bond of that divine love. Created in God's image, we too are called to live in love, unity, and communion with one another.

This feast reminds us that God is never distant. The Father created us, the Son redeemed us, and the Holy Spirit sanctifies and guides us each day. Even when we cannot fully comprehend the mystery of the Trinity, we can encounter God through prayer, the sacraments, and acts of charity.

As we celebrate this solemnity, may we grow in faith and gratitude for the presence of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in our lives, and may everything we do give glory to the Holy Trinity.
