Saints Martha, Mary, and Lazarus – Friends of Jesus



On **July 29**, the Church celebrates the Memorial of **Saints Martha, Mary, and Lazarus**, the beloved siblings whom Jesus called His friends. Their home in Bethany was a place where our Lord found welcome, rest, and friendship, reminding us that Christ desires to dwell not only in churches, but

also in our homes and hearts. The Gospels present each sibling as a model of Christian discipleship. **Martha** is remembered for her generous service and hospitality. **Mary** sits at the feet of Jesus, listening attentively to His word and reminding us of the importance of prayer and contemplation. **Lazarus**, whom Jesus raised from the dead, bears witness to Christ's power over sin and death and points us toward the hope of the Resurrection. While Martha and Mary approached the Lord in different ways, one through service and the other through quiet listening, Jesus loved them both. Their lives teach us that authentic discipleship includes both action and prayer. We are called to serve generously while also making time to sit quietly in the presence of the Lord. **As we celebrate this memorial, let us ask ourselves:** Is our home a place where Christ is welcomed? Do we make time each day to listen to His voice? Are we willing to serve others with the same love and generosity shown by Martha, Mary, and Lazarus? May their example inspire us to deepen our friendship with Christ and to welcome Him more fully into every aspect of our lives. **Saints Martha, Mary, and Lazarus, pray for us.**
