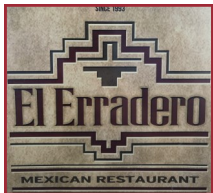

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

June 7th, 2026, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as Corpus Christi. On this special feast, we give thanks for the incredible gift of the Holy Eucharist—the true Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ.

At the Last Supper, Jesus gave Himself to His disciples under the appearances of bread and wine and commanded them to “do this in memory of me.” Through the Eucharist, Christ continues to nourish His people, strengthen our faith, and unite us as one Body in Him. The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life, the greatest treasure entrusted to the Church.

A cherished tradition of this feast is the Eucharistic Procession. As we carry the Blessed Sacrament beyond the walls of the church, we publicly proclaim our faith in Christ's Real Presence and invite Him to bless our parish, our community, and our homes. The procession is both an act of worship and a witness to the world that Jesus Christ walks among His people.

We invite all parishioners to participate in this beautiful expression of faith. Whether walking in the procession, praying along the route, or joining in adoration, let us come together to honor our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and deepen our love for the Eucharist.

May this feast renew our appreciation for the gift of Christ's presence among us and inspire us to carry His love into the world.
