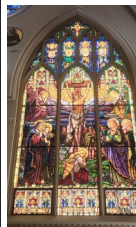
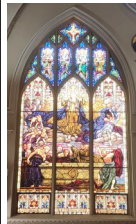


The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

As we look ahead to next week the Church prepares to celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on **August 15**. This joyful feast reminds us of the hope that awaits all who faithfully follow Christ. The Church teaches that at the end of her earthly life, the Blessed Virgin Mary was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory. Preserved from sin by God's grace and united perfectly to her Son, Mary shares fully in the victory of Christ over sin and death. Her Assumption is a sign of God's promise that eternal life awaits all who remain faithful to Him. Mary's life was one of complete trust in God's will. From her "yes" at the Annunciation to her presence at the foot of the Cross, she faithfully followed Christ with humility, courage, and love. The Windows Have Returned!



As many of you saw last week, the windows have been reinstalled. Some of you noticed a few imperfections and light spots. We met with Mike Rigali and his foreman, Andrew, who explained that these are expected during the restoration process. These windows were handcrafted more than 100 years ago, and like all historic stained glass, they have undergone repairs and touch-up work over the years. At the studio, each window is carefully taken apart, gently cleaned, and fitted with new lead. During the cleaning process, some of the previous touch-up work may be removed. While the windows are thoroughly inspected at the studio, certain imperfections only become visible once they are reinstalled and viewed in natural light. At

that point, the restoration team identifies any areas needing additional attention and consults with the owners to determine whether they should be touched up, repaired, or left as-is for historical provenance. Father, Dawn, Les, and Monique met with Andrew to review the areas needing attention, and the restoration team has been working on those items. **You may also notice that a face is currently missing from The Assumption window.** That piece has been taken back to the studio so it can be restored with the correct shape and fit. We don't have an estimated completion date yet, but we'll keep everyone updated.
