The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary

On August 22, the Church celebrates the Memorial of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This beautiful feast follows the Solemnity of the Assumption, reminding us that Mary, who was assumed body and soul into heaven, now shares in the glory of her Son. Calling Mary "Queen" does not place her above Christ. Rather, her queenship comes entirely from her relationship with Jesus, the King. From

the moment she said "yes" to God at the Annunciation, Mary gave herself completely to His plan. She carried the Savior of the world, stood faithfully at the foot of the Cross, and remained united with the disciples as they awaited the coming of the Holy Spirit.

Mary's queenship is one of love and service. She does not seek attention for herself, but continually leads us toward her Son. At Cana, her instruction was simple: "Do whatever he tells you." These words remain a beautiful summary of Mary's role in our lives. As we honor Mary as Queen, we are invited to imitate her humility, faith, and complete trust in God. She reminds us that true greatness is found not in power or status, but in giving ourselves generously to God's will. Let us turn to Mary with confidence, asking her to intercede for our families, our parish, and our community. May she guide us ever closer to Jesus and help us faithfully follow Him each day. **Mary, Queen of Heaven, pray for us!**
