St. Augustine – A Heart Restless for God

On August 28, the Church celebrates the memorial of St. Augustine, Bishop and Doctor of the Church. Augustine's life is one of the great stories of conversion in the history of Christianity. He was a brilliant thinker who spent many years searching for truth and pursuing the things of this world before finally surrendering his heart to God. Born in 354 in North Africa, Augustine was raised by his Christian mother, St. Monica, who prayed faithfully for her son throughout his life. Although Augustine knew about Christianity, he struggled to live according to its teachings. He searched for truth in philosophy and other beliefs, yet nothing truly satisfied the longing within his heart.

Through the prayers of his mother, the guidance of St. Ambrose, and the grace of God, Augustine eventually experienced a profound conversion. He was baptized at the age of 33 and later became a priest and bishop. His writings became some of the most influential works in Christian history. St. Augustine famously wrote, **"Our hearts are restless until they rest in you."** His words express something that every human heart can recognize. We may search for happiness in possessions, success, relationships, entertainment, or countless other things, but ultimately our hearts are made for God.

Augustine's story reminds us that God's grace can reach us even when we have wandered far from Him. His life also reminds us never to give up praying for those we love. St. Monica prayed for Augustine for many years before seeing the fruits of those prayers. As we celebrate St. Augustine, may we ask God to give us hearts that seek Him above all else. And may we remember that, no matter where we are in our journey of faith, God's invitation to come home is always there. **St. Augustine, pray for us!**
