We will be starting in September, taking communion to our church families who are not able to join us in church. If you would be willing to take communion to a family once a month, please contact Dawn or Ann and sign up.


The Finance Council will be giving a report on the financial status of our parish on September 7 & 8, 2019. Please try to attend Mass on one of these days to find out how we are doing.
