Congratulations to all of the young people who were confirmed on Thursday and to all of the children who received their first communion today. We are truly blessed to have such a wonderful church family.

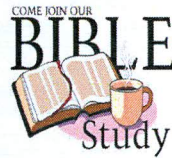

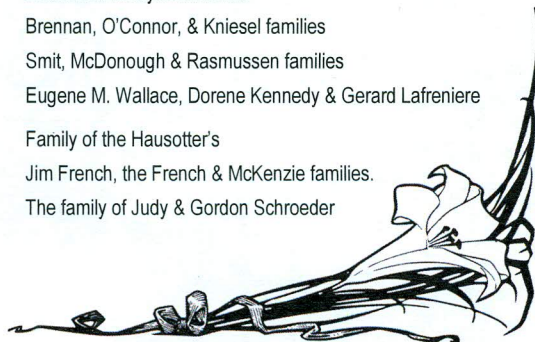
